

INTRODUCTION TO OUTDOOR LEADER SKILLS

Learning Objectives

- Know how to accomplish outdoor skills for Troop camping while fulfilling advancement requirements.
- Acquire the skills necessary for instructing Scouts using the EDGE method (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide, Enable) the steps to lead, plan and carry out successful campouts.
- Increase leaders' knowledge of BSA outdoor skills resources.
- Demonstrate the outdoor skills necessary for basic campouts.

BSA requires that you have at least one IOLS-trained adult on every Scouts BSA overnight outdoor event.

- You will receive a registration confirmation letter via email from the course director prior to the event that will include what to bring with you.
- You will not receive credit for the training if you are not present the whole course or leave early.
- You will also need to complete the online position specific training for your position (at my.scouting.org) PRIOR to attending the in-person IOLS training. Log into my.scouting.org; scroll down a little; click on "BSA Learn Center"; find your position specific training (Scoutmaster/ Assistant scoutmaster) and complete it. The modules are from 5 to 15 minutes in length.

Dates: Friday and Saturday, March 10 – 11, 2023

Check in: 5:30pm Friday, March 10

We will be done by 6:00pm on Saturday, March 11

Cost: \$30.00 per participant, paid when you register online (covers food – breakfast and lunch; training patch; Certificate)

Location: Glade Park.

Take the Monument Road; at the Ranger Station entrance, let them know you are going to "Glade Park". There will be no charge to travel thru.

Observe the speed signs and watch for bikes and wildlife!

Just past Cold Shivers, at the Glade Park Sign turn left towards Glade Park. You are then on DS Road.

Watch the mile makers.

At the 25-mile marker you will see Mesa County Bowman's Archery on your right, go about ½ mile and there is a turn off on your right.

There will be a sign.

If you get to mile marker 24, you have gone too far.

This is primitive camping; you will receive a list of what to bring in a confirmation email.

There will be a porta potty.

There is no water, you must bring what you need.
