- Know how to accomplish outdoor skills for Troop camping while fulfilling advancement requirements.
- Acquire the skills necessary for instructing Scouts using the EDGE method (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide, Enable) the steps to lead, plan and carry out successful campouts.
- Increase leaders' knowledge of BSA outdoor skills resources.
- Demonstrate the outdoor skills necessary for basic campouts.

BSA requires that you have at least one IOLS-trained adult on every Scouts BSA overnight outdoor event.

• You will not receive credit for the training if you are not present the whole course or leave early.

• You will also need to complete the online position specific training for your position (at my.scouting.org) PRIOR to attending the in-person IOLS training. Log into my.scouting.org; scroll down a little; click on "BSA Learn Center"; find your position specific training (Scoutmaster/ Assistant scoutmaster) and complete it. The modules are from 5 to 15 minutes in length.
